<u>Lighting</u> - \$3 off LED bulbs, \$8 off Energy Star Fixtures, Efficient Porch Lighting	<u>Furnace</u> - \$300-\$400 Rebate
<u>Water Heater</u> -\$500 Rebate (hybrid heat pump, electric)	<u>Water Heaters</u> - \$100- \$400 Rebate
<u>Thermostats</u> - \$100 Rebate	<u>Boilers</u> - \$400 - \$700 Rebate
<u>HVAC</u> - \$300 to \$1500 Rebate	<u>Gas Dryer</u> -\$50 Rebate
<u>Appliance Recycling</u> - \$50 Rebate, to schedule a pickup, have your Pepco account number handy	Note: Residents must use <u>a registered contractor</u> Contractors complete the rebate application for you.
<u>Pool Pump</u> - \$400 Rebate on a variable speed pump	
<u>Dehumidifier</u> - \$30 Rebate	
<u>Quick Home Energy Checkup</u> - Free	
<u>Home Performance with ENERGY Star</u> – a whole house energy audit for \$100	
<u>Income Eligible Energy Efficiency Program</u> – administered by Department of Housing and Community Development	
<u>Peak Energy Savings Credit</u> – \$5 bill credit for each peak savings day, enroll in your account	<u>Washington Gas Flyer</u>
<u>Energy Wise Rewards</u> – Rebates for enrolling a smart thermostat, 1-866-353-5798	<u>Washington Gas Program Overview</u> (bottom of page)
